Syrians under TPS are within the working age (19-64). Whereas

of them were given work permit in 2017. Bureaucratic obstacles drive Syrians into the informal economy, possibly resulting in work accidents, sub-minimum wages and violation of social rights.

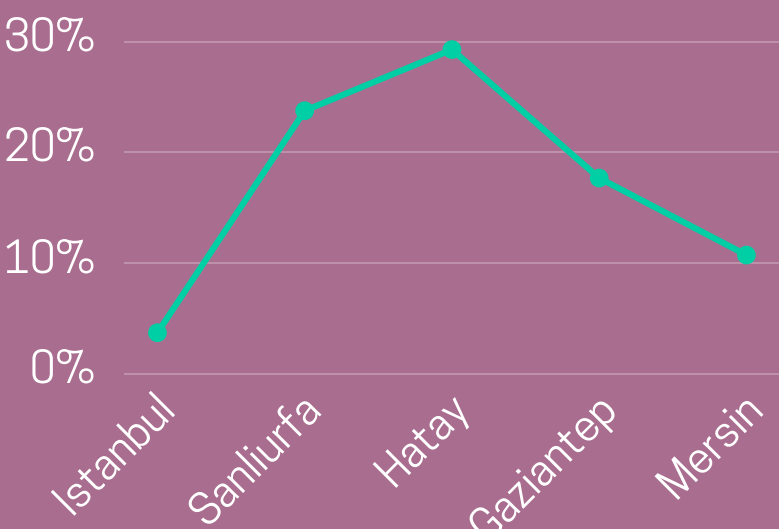
A little over 1,5 million Syrians under Temporary Protection Status (TPS) are females, whereas the male population stands at over 1,8 million. December 2017, DGMM

SYRIANS IN CITIES

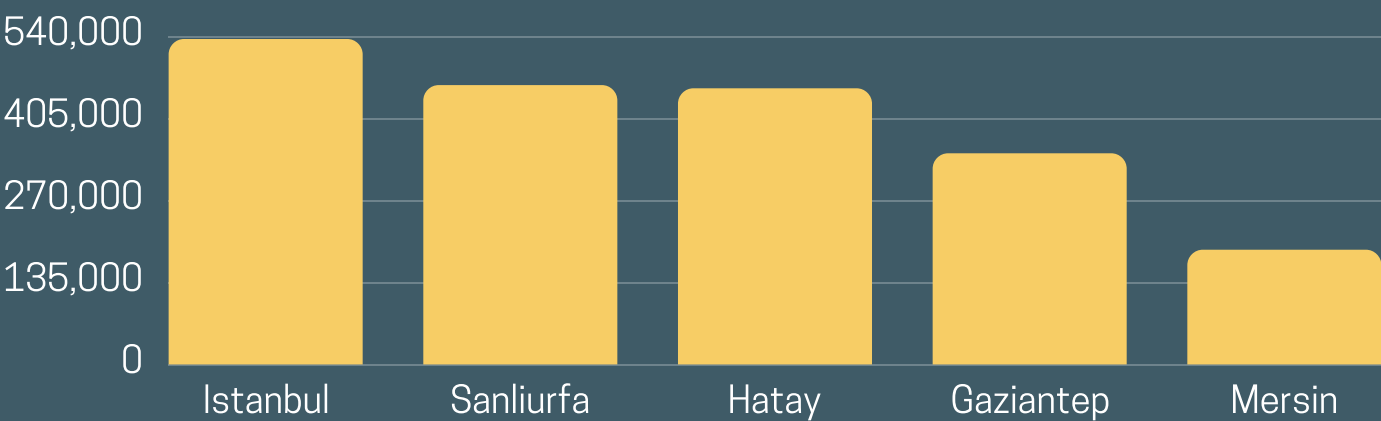
While Syrians represent 3% of the total Istanbul population, this ratio may reach up to 30% in southern cities of Turkey. Hatay, a Turkish-Syrian border city, has 30% of Syrian population as a proportion of the total city population.
